ADDING A WHITE BORDER

If you want to add a white border to make your image stand out from the projected background, where your image fills the 1024 X 768 canvas, you can select all of your image and stroke it in white.—

OUTLINE BORDER IN PHOTOSHOP CS

In the SELECT menu click on ALL.

In the EDIT menu select STROKE

Set the width in pixels that you want your border to be

Set the colour to White, default is the current foreground colour.

Select INSIDE under Location

Click the OK button.

OUTLINE BORDER IN PHOTOSHOP ELEMENTS

In the SELECT menu click on ALL.

In the EDIT menu select STROKE (OUTLINE) SELECTION

Set the width in pixels that you want your border to be

Set the colour to White, default is the current foreground colour.

Select INSIDE under Location

Click the OK button.

NOTE -

If you want to add a white border, where your image is smaller than the 1024 X 768 canvas, you need to carry out the above before setting the canvas size or manually select the area instrad of selecting all at step 1..
