

ADDING A WHITE BORDER

If you want to add a white border to make your image stand out from the projected background, where your image fills the 1024 X 768 canvas, you can select all of your image and stroke it in white.–

OUTLINE BORDER IN PHOTOSHOP CS

In the **SELECT** menu click on **ALL**.

In the **EDIT** menu select **STROKE**

Set the width in pixels that you want your border to be

Set the colour to White, default is the current foreground colour.

Select **INSIDE** under **Location**

Click the OK button.

OUTLINE BORDER IN PHOTOSHOP ELEMENTS

In the **SELECT** menu click on **ALL**.

In the **EDIT** menu select **STROKE (OUTLINE) SELECTION**

Set the width in pixels that you want your border to be

Set the colour to White, default is the current foreground colour.

Select **INSIDE** under **Location**

Click the OK button.

NOTE –

If you want to add a white border, where your image is smaller than the 1024 X 768 canvas, you need to carry out the above before setting the canvas size or manually select the area instead of selecting all at step 1..
